A Message from Mr. Freke

Greetings to you all,

I would like to start my 'blurb' by thanking everyone who contributed to the series of awesome events we had last week. The Zoo trips went very smoothly due to the wonderful parent support, and great organisation, and it was awesome to see so many of you support our athletics day on Friday. Miss Bunker did a great job organising the weather so it wasn't too hot or raining. The other big event was the Diwali pop-up festival on Thursday which was run by another group of amazing parents. It was great to see so many parents in our school supporting their children's learning.

Mrs Campbell and I were lucky to be selected by Waikato University to be part of a group that travelled to Hangzhou in China to look at how we can form sustainable 'Sister-School' partnerships. A big part of 'sister-school' partnerships is to get children to understand different cultural perspectives with an aim to equip children to work with a range of cultures in the future. In my view Endeavour students are already very well placed. We have many different nationalities and cultures at Endeavour School, our students are lucky to be exposed to global perspectives every day. This is very different from what was in Hangzhou. At the schools we visited we only saw Chinese children, most of whom came from high-rise apartments really close to the school. There was a real desire on the part of the Chinese schools to expose their children to Western/New Zealand culture. Mrs Campbell and I are exploring how we can use the OECG Global competencies framework as a basis for our sharing of learning.

Congratulations to the Friends of Endeavour who ran their first 'Spring Festival'. Though it was relatively small in scale, the feedback was that it was very successful and there are some great ideas to build upon for next year.

Thank you everyone for the ongoing understanding and support of the NZEI contract negotiations and strike. We sincerely hope that it will be the last strike and the government will start to listen to our concerns about the crisis facing education.

We are down to the last four weeks of 2018! There are lots of events planned so please keep an eye out on Facebook and the website for regular updates. Good luck to all those involved in sport this week and go the ABs.
